HOLY COMMUNION FROM THE CHALICE (ST. JOSEPH'S)

From this weekend (2/3 December), Holy Communion will be given under **both kinds**. Recipients can receive the Precious Blood from the chalice if they want to.

How to receive from the chalice?

After receiving the Host in a usual manner (by hand or tongue), recipients go to the minister with the chalice, respond 'Amen' and take the chalice from the minister, have a sip from the chalice, and return it to the minister.

Please note: Recipients should receive the precious Blood directly from the chalice. <u>Intinction is NOT allowed.</u>

If you don't receive from the chalice, please return to your seats reverently as usual after receiving the Host.

DO YOU KNOW

What is required to receive Holy Communion? To receive Holy Communion, one must be <u>fully</u> <u>incorporated</u> into the Catholic Church and be in the <u>state of grace</u>, that is, not conscious of being in mortal sin.

How to receive the Host?

If you are receiving the Host in your hand, extend both hands palms up toward the Priest/Eucharistic Minister, placing one hand directly on top of the other hand. If you are right handed, the right hand goes on the bottom so you can receive the Host in your left hand and then pick it up with your right hand.

How to receive from the chalice?

After receiving the Host in a usual manner (by hand or tongue), recipients go to the minister with the chalice, respond 'Amen' and take the chalice from the minister, have a sip from the chalice, and return it to the minister.

Intinction is NOT allowed.
