## DO YOU KNOW

**What is required to receive Holy Communion?**  
To receive Holy Communion, one must be **fully incorporated** into the Catholic Church and be in the **state of grace**, that is, not conscious of being in mortal sin.

### How to receive the Host?

If you are receiving the Host in your hand, **extend both hands palms up** toward the Priest/Eucharistic Minister, **placing one hand directly on top of the other hand**. If you are right handed, the right hand goes on the bottom so you can receive the Host in your left hand and then pick it up with your right hand.

### How to receive from the chalice?

After receiving the Host in a usual manner (by hand or tongue), recipients go to the minister with the chalice, respond 'Amen' and take the chalice from the minister, **have a sip** from the chalice, and return it to the minister.

**Intinction is NOT allowed.**

## THE ANGELUS PRAYER

∞. The Angel of the Lord declared unto Mary,  
**∞. And she conceived of the Holy Spirit. Hail Mary...**
