DO YOU KNOW?

Holy Week is the final week of Lent. It begins with the commemoration of Christ's triumphal entry into Jerusalem on Palm Sunday, the Sunday before Easter. It is a time when Christians gather to remember and participate in the Passion of Jesus Christ. The Sacred Paschal Triduum is the central liturgical celebration. The three liturgies of Holy Thursday (Mass of the Lord's Supper), Good Friday (the Passion), and the Easter Vigil (the Resurrection) are, in fact, ONE continuous liturgy that commemorates the passion, death, and resurrection of our Lord Jesus Christ.

All statues and images covered/veiled from the fifth Sunday Lent to heighten our senses and build within us a longing for Easter Sunday.
