DO YOU KNOW

What is required to receive Holy Communion? To receive Holy Communion, one must be <u>fully incorporated</u> into the Catholic Church and be in the <u>state of grace</u>, that is, not conscious of being in mortal sin.

What is a mortal sin? A mortal sin is one that "destroys in us the charity without which eternal beatitude is impossible. Unrepented, it brings eternal death" (CCC 1874). There are three ingredients in a mortal sin: (1) "grave matter," (2) "full knowledge," and (3) "deliberate consent." (CCC1857) Grave matter is specified bν the Ten Commandments (CCC1858). Ten The Commandments lay out "the first principles" of the moral law; they're not an exhaustive list of every serious sin. The right question is this: is this the kind of behaviour that places something else above God or turns me away from God? If so, it's grave matter.
