DO YOU KNOW

Why going to Sunday Mass is absolutely necessary? Sunday Mass fulfils God's law (Third Commandment). It's our *duty* to give Him the worship He deserves, and our *loving response* to the God who has loved us first.

Why do we make the Sign of the Cross on our heads, lips, and chests before listening to the Gospel at Mass? It is a way of praying, "May the Lord be in my mind, on my lips, and in my heart;" a way of prayerfully inviting Christ to come to us in these ways as His sacred Word is proclaimed. The hearing of the Gospel must change our minds, it must be proclaimed by our lips, and it must affect our hearts, i.e. our wills, affections, emotions, and passions.

What is required to receive Holy Communion? To receive Holy Communion, one must be <u>fully incorporated</u> into the Catholic Church and be in the <u>state of grace</u>, that is, not conscious of being in mortal sin.
