## DO YOU KNOW

#### Why do we pray for the dead?

The answer lies in scripture, Catholic tradition and Catholic teaching and belief about purgatory. What is purgatory?

Purgatory is defined by the Catechism of the Catholic Church as a **"purification**, so as to achieve the holiness necessary to enter the joy of heaven," which is undergone by those "who **die in God's grace and friendship, but still imperfectly purified**" (CCC 1030). "This final purification of the elect... is entirely different from the punishment of the damned" (CCC 1031).

# Can praying for the dead really help the souls in purgatory?

YES, as the Bible and Catholic tradition point out, our prayers can help the heaven-bound souls in purgatory. Once in heaven, these purified souls, or saints, can intercede for others before the throne of God—making our prayers for the souls in purgatory even more meaningful in the long term. St. Pope John Paul II said that "praying for the souls in purgatory is the highest act of supernatural charity."
