HOLY WEEK & PASCHAL TRIDUUM

Holy Week is the final week of Lent. It begins with the commemoration of Christ's triumphal entry into Jerusalem on **Palm Sunday**, the Sunday before Easter. It is a time when Christians gather to remember and participate in the **Passion** of Jesus Christ.

The Sacred Paschal Triduum is the central liturgical celebration. The THREE liturgies of Holy Thursday (Mass of the Lord's Supper), Good Friday (the Passion), and the Easter Vigil (the Resurrection) are, in fact, ONE continuous liturgy that commemorates the passion, death, and resurrection of our Lord Jesus Christ.

Holy Oils: 1) the oil of the catechumens (for the sacrament of Baptism), 2) the holy chrism oil (for the sacraments of Baptism, Confirmation & Ordination), and 3) the oil of the sick (for the sacrament of the anointing the sick). These oils are blessed/consecrated by the Bishop ordinarily during the annual Chrism Mass and used in all parishes throughout the year.

<u>Maundy Thursday Watch</u> – adoration of Our Lord in the Blessed Sacrament today recalls how Jesus invited his apostles to stay with him while he prayed. In a certain sense, Jesus challenges all of us to keep watch with him for at least one hour on Holy Thursday, as he challenged his apostles on that fateful night.
