Divine Mercy Sunday was added to the Church's Calendar in 2000 when Pope St. JP II canonised St. Faustina who received a private revelation from the Lord. The Divine Mercy image depicts Jesus at the moment he appears to the disciples in the Upper Room, after the Resurrection, when he empowers them to forgive or retain sins.

A plenary indulgence, granted under the usual conditions (sacramental confession, Eucharistic communion and prayer for the intentions of Supreme Pontiff) to the faithful who, on the Second Sunday of Easter or Divine Mercy Sunday, take part in the prayers and devotions held in honour of Divine Mercy.

DO YOU KNOW

The mystery of Christ's resurrection is a <u>real event</u>, with manifestations that were historically verified, as the New Testament bears witness. In about A.D. 56, St. Paul could already write to the Corinthians: "I delivered to you as of first importance what I also received, that Christ died for our sins in accordance with the scriptures, and that he was buried, that he was raised on the third day in accordance with the scriptures, and that he appeared to Cephas, then to the Twelve..." The Apostle speaks here of the living tradition of the Resurrection which he had learned after his conversion at the gates of Damascus. (CCC 639)

Easter is **NOT** finished on Easter Sunday. The <u>fifty</u> <u>days</u> from Easter Sunday of the Resurrection to Pentecost Sunday are celebrated in joy and exultation as **ONE** feast day. Let the Joy of Easter be with us and our families today and always.
