Life is often about picking our way through opposites - choices and decisions that surround every moment of every day: should I do this or that, choose this way or that way, and so on. Just as there are choices on either side, so there are opposing

In Saint Luke's version of the Beati-tudes. we see Jesus setting out very clearly the teaching that life is about choices, and that we must take control, and be responsi-ble for the life we choose, or even the condi-tions of life that we embrace or accept.
