THE WORD THIS WEEK

While the world may seem to be very indifferent to Christianity most of the time, it can be very critical of Christians who do not seem to be following the most basic tenet of their faith - to be a people of "good deeds", as Jesus teaches in today's portion of the Sermon on the Mount.
