SAINT OF THE WEEK: St Osburg Feast 9 September

Although nothing else is known about her, there was a strong cult to St Osburg in Coventry during the Middle Ages. In the nineteenth century revival of Catholicism, Bishop Ullathorne dedicated the first Catholic church in the city to her. September 9 is the date when Bishop Wiseman consecrated the new church of St Osburg in Coventry in 1845.
