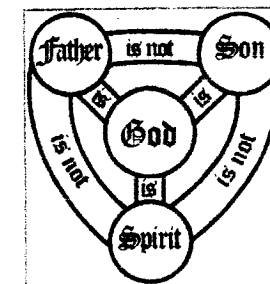

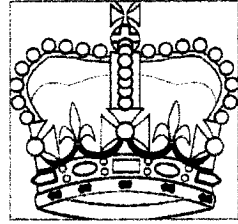


The Diamond Jubilee of Her Majesty Queen Elizabeth II

During Mass, the first reading is replaced by 1Kings 3:11-14 & the Prayer for the Queen, which has been approved by the Bishops, is used after the Post Communion Prayer & before the Final Blessing.
