THE WORD THIS WEEK

The 1st reading, from Exodus, forms part of the regulations concerning the Covenant made by Moses in the blood of sacrificial animals. The image of sacrifice is then taken up in the Psalm. In the 2nd reading, from the Letter to the Hebrews, we hear of the better covenant made by Jesus, not with the bulls' or goats' blood but with his own blood shed for us. The animal sacrifices, once central to people's lives (including Jesus himself) are made a thing of the past. In the Gospel we have part of Mark's account of the Last Supper. Note the words 'poured out for many'. It is the presence of these words in Scripture that is the reason they are now in the Mass. They mean 'for all.'

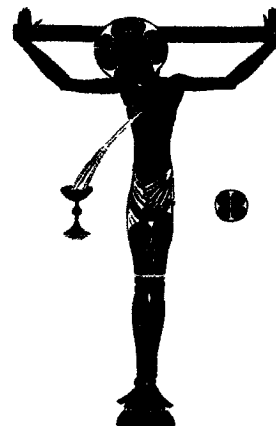
