#### THE WORD THIS WEEK

In the East, this Season of Christmas is called the "Time of Manifestation", or Showing. Today is the 'Feast of the Manifestation', or the Showing of the Saviour to the whole world, to all nations. In the wise men who travel from the East, we see all the nations other than the people of Israel being welcomed at the New Temple of the New Covenant - the new born child in the manger. A look at the Psalm response shows this: "All nations shall fall prostrate before you, O Lord." The same is true of the key word in the second reading: "Revelation". Remember that for the people of Israel this was to be their Messiah, come to restore



their fortunes. By this feast, we proclaim God's plan was to extend his salvation to men and women of every nation, of every time and every place - including us. In many ways this is our Christmas Feast, when we celebrate the Good News of the Saviour's birth revealed at last to us.

## SAINT OF THE WEEK 12 January: St Aelred of Rievaulx

Aelred was born in Hexham, Northumbria, in 1110. At 24 he entered the Cistercian abbey of Rievaulx, Yorkshire & in 1147 was elected abbot. Under his administration, the abbey is said to have grown to 100 monks & 400 lay brothers. Aelred wrote several influential books on spirituality, among them Speculum caritatis ("The Mirror of Charity") & De spiritali amicitia ("On Spiritual Friendship"). Aelred was generally known as an historian rather than as a spiritual writer; for many centuries his most famous work was his Life of St Edward, King & Confessor. He died on Jan 12, 1167, at Rievaulx & was canonized in 1191.
